Decoding Technical Education/Career-Engineering: A study of Planetary Yogs/Combinations as per Vedic Numerology

Abstract

“Everything around you is numbers.” Shakuntala Devi.

“Numbers are the highest degree of knowledge. It is knowledge itself.”- Plato

The date, we were born on, was not an accident. Each number in our date of birth is connected with certain energies and vibrations. The careful study of these universal divine energies can reveal, who you are, what is your personality, nature, thinking and what is your future in terms of family, career, relationships and finances etc.

This research paper explores the intricate world of numerology, specifically examining the planetary number combinations and Yogs as described by Prof. Ashok Bhatia. These combinations show how planets interact and affect our lives. There are 51 number combinations divided into six distinct parts: Number Conjunction, Hostile Numbers, Square Aspect, Triangular Relation, Hypotenuse and Diagonal Relation. These 51 number combinations reveal how the planetary interactions impact the various aspects of an individual's life.

In this research study, we will study & analyze the number combination or Yogs related to Technical & Professional Education applicable for Engineering as education and/or career/profession. In this study, an attempt has been made to analyze the number combinations or Yogs pertinent to Technical Education and Profession, with a particular emphasis on Engineering and how these numbers in date of birth can emerge as a directional guide for an individual to choose any specific career/profession (by studying the patterns of over 1000+ date of births).

By systematically studying these number combinations, this paper aims to provide a deeper understanding of how numerology can influence educational and career paths in Engineering.

The findings could offer valuable guidance for individuals seeking to align their educational and professional pursuits with their inherent numerical strengths and planetary influences. However, individual choice & environmental factors and their impact cannot be ruled out.

The focus of this research study is to study & understand the three specific number combinations/ Yogs, as per Vedic Numerology, identified as especially important and relevant to Engineering education and careers.

Introduction

Numerology is the science, philosophy and a universal divine language of numbers (1 to 9) where each number has its own strength, potential, vibratory influence and challenge which can uncover information about an individual. Based on the belief that a person comes into this life on a certain date and at a certain time with a certain name, numerology uses numbers to tell who a person is and can provide astounding insights about the map for his / her life. The numbers in our date of birth represent certain qualities, traits endowed by the universe to the native and can reveal a lot of details.

To study & understand the hidden number combinations present in the date of birth, we first need to understand that from where Vedic-Astro numerology originates. Then, we will understand the certain number combinations/Yogs by way of simple, easy and logical calculations & with the help of relevant case studies.

Vedic Astrology and The Navagrahas – Significance of 9 Planetary Gods

Firstly, it is important to note nothing in Vedic astrology is actually referred to as a “planet.” Astrologers instead use the Sanskrit term *Graha*, which literally translates as “that which grabs or holds.”




Fig 1: Navagraha

As per Jyotish Shastra (*Vedic Astrology*), nine planets have particular functions in the natal chart and represent special energies. These nine planets are collectively known as “Navagrahas.” (Fig 1)

The Navagraha word is derived from the Sanskrit words "Nava" and "Graha". Nava means "Nine", Graha means "energy, planet or spiritual body". Graha (from Sanskrit ग्रह grāha - seizing, laying hold of, holding, or controlling, grasping or cognizing power).

Navagraha represents the nine celestial influencers in Vedic Astrology & are considered to play a major role in deciding the destiny of man & are responsible for all good or bad times, one faces in life. Planets are described therefore as *grahas*, because of the way they take hold of and influence life. Thus the term 'graha' in this contexts applies to the nine (9) planetary or cosmic deities, spirits, spiritual beings-entities, etc in general.

The Navagrahas are Surya (Sun), Chandra (Moon), Mangal (Mars), Budha (Mercury), Brihaspati (Jupiter), Shukra (Venus), Shani (Saturn), Rahu (North Lunar Node) and Ketu (South Lunar Node).

While the first seven are physical forms, Rahu and Ketu are called Chaya Grahas or Shadow Planets. They represent the two points in space where the orbital path of the sun and moon intersect. Because eclipses block light and occur in connection to the nodes, Rahu and Ketu are often called “Shadow Planets,” and are generally indicators of negative influences. Each planet influences our lives according to the position on the Birth Charts. According to Vedic Astrology, the positioning of these nine planets, (on the date of birth, at

that particular time of birth & the place of birth) in a person’s horoscope called Kundali influences his/her life & determines his potential in life.

The seven days of the week in the Hindu calendar also correspond with the Navagraha (from the first seven planets) and are named accordingly.

From Navagrahas to Sepharial Numerology

Sepharial (Walter Gorn Old) was a well-known and respected astrologer in the late 19th and early 20th centuries & wrote numerous books. Sepharial had come to India for seeking knowledge and later, visited Egypt in that pursuit.

About a hundred years ago, Sepharial wrote his book titled 'Kabala of Numbers' based on Navagraha Yantras and his own experiences. He has given a new dimension to the Numerology by making a Grid and developed it further, which was basically based on the Indian Nine Planetary System.

In his Ank Chakra, he has assigned the central place to number 7 and according to him, number 7 stands for the Moon (+). Infact, Moon is the signifier of the mind, heart and mother. In the Indian system, Rahu and Ketu are taken as shadow planets, but Sepharial called them Sun (-) and Moon (-) and detailed the characteristics of the 7 planets.

These numbers, 1 to 9, are divided into three groups, namely, **The Spiritual, The Emotional and The Physical.** Thus, **the Sun 1, Jupiter 3 and Mars 9, are the spiritual numbers.**

The Moon 7, Mercury 5 and Venus 6, are the emotional numbers; **while Saturn 8, Sun 4 and Moon 2, are the physical numbers.**

We have, therefore, a second arrangement of these nine figures (Converted Navagraha Yantra), which now stands as follows:-

From Sepharial Numerology to Vedic Astro Numerology
AnkGuru Prof. Ashok Bhatia, in his book – “Vedic Astro Numerology”, after his more than 35 years long research,

gave different dimensions to the numbers. Prof. Bhatia mentions that in the present times, we can understand Sepharial's system based on Indian Vedic Astrology in the form of Vedic Number combination Chart or Vedic Grid as follows:-

Every little change in the position of these planets and stars affects individuals, by affecting different parts of the body and the flow of blood. The circulating blood transmits the changes to every part of the body immediately. The planets are considered to display following traits & characteristics in the human body.

- Surya (Sun)** signifies the Soul & has been assigned number 1. It is the King of all the planets. Brilliant and illuminating, Surya is the storehouse of spiritual energy. The body derives energy from Surya.
- Chandrama (Moon)** controls the Mind has been assigned number 2, Chandrama is known as the master of medicines. Since it controls the mind, it is also known as the king of the mind.
- Mangal (Mars)** controls blood circulation, has been assigned number 9, Mangal is symbolic of Kartikeya. He is the commander of forces, known to be stern, merciless, very powerful and strong.
- Budh (Mercury)** gives the power to think, has been assigned number 5. Budh is wise, intelligent and sharp.
- Brihaspati (Jupiter)** is the Acharya & Guru of all the gods and is known as Devguru, has been assigned number 3, eternally strong and powerful.
- Shukra (Venus)** ensures virility, has been assigned number 6 and Shukra is benevolent and brings honour and fame. He also promotes good health and virility.
- Shani (Saturn)** is responsible for happiness and sorrow, has been assigned number 8. Shani is known to create most problems.
- Rahu** has been assigned number 4 & **Ketu** has been assigned number 7, both are known to be the agents of Shani. Both Rahu and Ketu are always on the prowl creating problems whenever they can.

Together all the planets (celestial bodies) control the entire body.

Thus, we can say that Vedic-Astro Numerology is the science that studies and forecasts the effects of these planets on the lives of people, as per numbers assigned to them.

To understand & study the certain Yogs, we will first study the meaning of Engineers, for common person.

- Engineers:** An Engineer can be defined as a person who uses scientific knowledge to design, construct & maintain engines, machines or structures such as Roads, railways, bridges, buildings etc. They are professionals with proper education in the field of engineering and are trained in or follow, as a profession, a branch of engineering.
- Engineers cum Arbitrators:** Engineering arbitration can be described as to settle engineering disputes through arbitration or reconciliation or other alternative methods. They are highly qualified and well experienced Arbitrator Engineers having technical and professional engineering competence with great know-how of engineering intricacies, are empaneled /registered with established Arbitration organizations.



Materials and Methods

The date of birth of any individual is the very first numerical association of his or her life, consisting date, month and year. Its numerical analysis can be done by analyzing the Vedic grid as per Vedic Numerology. This helps us to understand how the energy of numbers work together with the energy of ruling planet in the native's life.

To study the certain Yogs, present in the date of birth, the Vedic Grid, as shown below, is used for plotting the numbers of Date of Birth & relevant Dasha numbers.

Other than the above combinations present in the birth chart, if these numbers (1, 3, 5, 9) appear as **Mahadasha, Antardasha, Varshfal and Gochar** and fulfill the above combinations, then the concerned event may take place in that particular period.

For Example

The Native, who wants to pursue Engineering (education or as job/profession), does not have 9 number in the birth chart but it is appearing in the Vedic grid for that particular period as the Mahadasha, Antardasha, Varshfal and Gochar, then there are chances of completing Engineering Education or starting Engineering career during that period.

Each and every number has a distinct direct or indirect influence on native's life. Let us first understand the significance of the numbers -1, 3, 5 & 9 & their corresponding Yogs in detail.



No.1 is associated with **Sun, the Soul**, & represents father, strong will power, initiative, originality, authoritative, strong determination, disciplined, ego, positivity, government jobs and its related work, higher position in the job, administrative qualities.

In Vedic grid, presence of no.1 is indicative of leadership qualities, creativity, positivity, strength and focus, self-reliance, commanding nature.



No.3 signifies expansion & is governed by Jupiter. Jupiter represents the Luck & Wisdom and renders us the knowledge of the dimensions of the universe and of the individual soul as well. It also accords all sorts of growth, mental development, financial growth, success, creativity and bestows the native with Self-expression, joy, laughter, spirituality, disciplined, self-centered (possessive traits), generosity, helpful nature for other's welfare, philosophical & scholarly nature, with worldly luxuries, comforts, wisdom & longevity.

Jupiter also stands for the divine blessings, male issues, profession of teacher, professor, bank officer, writer, astrologer, learning, wisdom, financial gains, religion, higher position and status, elder brother, love marriage and can also give immoral relations.



No. 5 is governed by **Mercury**, the Lord of Speech who symbolizes and represents mental and intellectual prowess. It stands for intelligence, wisdom and logic, education, speech, profession, writing power, memory, the power of thinking, astrology, love marriage and divorce.

Mercury also denotes medical sciences, mathematics, writing power, technology, legal practice, trade & commerce as well as handicrafts, arts



No. 9 is associated with **Mars**, & it stands for courage & valor, strength, power toughness, positive and negative energy, will-power, engineering, surgeon, military related services, popularity, prestige, reputation, success, younger brother.

Presence of no.9 in the Vedic grid indicates that native can become an engineer, chemist, scientist, doctor or an army chief and can succeed in adventurous pursuits & can gain from work related to Fire, Furnace, Chimney etc.

Let us now understand the relevant number combinations in detail:

5. Can succeed in the field of engineering, medical (doctor), surgery.

- 3-1-9 (Jupiter-Sun-Mars Hypotenuse Relation)**
Combination of Jupiter, Sun & Mars (3, 1 & 9) in the Vedic grid gives following results:
1. Makes the native brilliant, self-confident, aggressive, fearless, ambitious, courageous, adventures,
 2. Gives higher education, delay in marriage
 3. Bestows with knowledge, respect & reputation, name & fame
 4. Can succeed in the field of law (judge), engineering, politics, medical(doctor) as well as astrologer (occult sciences)
 5. Combination of Sun & Jupiter gives traits like ambitions, possessiveness, recognition from intellectual achievements. Whereas combination of Jupiter & Mars gives the native ability to be a mathematician, craftsman, scholarly person, with very good & deep knowledge.

Conclusion & Findings

In this Research based study, a total of 1000 case studies of Engineers from different streams were studied. After detailed working & analysis of the given Birth & Education Details, the findings about various factors are as follows




Fig 1: Bars indicating the presence of relevant Yogs for Engineering Education/ career, in Date of Birth, appearing in Dasha and No yog present at all.

Cases with Engineering Yog

- 66% natives had Applicable Yog for Technical/ Engineering Education /Career in their Vedic Birth Grid.
- 26% natives who didn't have the required yog originally in their Birth Grid, they were able to complete their Technical (Engineering) Education when the required number appeared during the MahaDasha (MD), Antardasha (AD), Varshfal (VF) and/or Gochar (G) in their Vedic Grid.
- However, 8% natives neither had the required yog in their Birth Grid nor in the Dasha Grid. Still they were able to successfully complete their Technical (Engineering) education. They are considered as Exceptional cases, as their Destiny & Karma played their roles.




Fig 2: Pie Chart indicating the presence of relevant Yogs for Engineering Education/ career in Date of Birth, appearing in Dasha and No yog present at all.

Role of Prevailing Dasha**Dasha number appearing & forming Engineering Yog**

The cases, where the Applicable Engineering yog were not present in the original Vedic Birth Grid & the Relevant Yogs were formed as a result of ongoing Dasha, natives completed their Technical (Engineering) Education during that particular Mahadasha. Following are the observations:

- Out of the 26% such total cases, approximately more than 50% natives had Mars Mahadasha going on while they acquired their Technical Educational Qualification.
- Next positions were dominated by Saturn Mahadasha (19.2%) & Ketu Mahadasha (15.4%) of such cases.
- Whereas other planetary dashas were present in less than 8% cases.

Exceptional cases: No Yog Formed

The exceptional cases, where neither the Applicable Engineering yog were present in the original Vedic Birth Grid, & nor the relevant yogs were formed & still the natives completed their Technical (Engineering) Education, following are the observations.

- Out of the 8% such total cases, approximately 37.5% natives had Ketu Mahadasha going on while they acquired their Technical Educational Qualification.
- Next position had an influence of Saturn Mahadasha (25%) of such cases.
- Whereas other planetary dashas (Mars, Jupiter & Venus) were present in 12.5% cases respectively.

Certain Other Observations

Considering the above findings, it becomes important to study the presence of other supporting numbers in the DOBs, which can be considered for Technical Education.

In general, there was a significant presence of no. 4 (Rahu) in approximately 36% cases out of total cases,

- Where 26% cases were those which had the relevant yog in Original Birth grid.
- 7% cases where relevant yog were formed during the Dasha,
- Whereas 3% cases were those where no yog formed during ongoing Mahadasha, Antardasha, Varshfal or Gochar.

Another significant number present was no 6 (Venus) in approximately 30% cases which can be bifurcated as:-

- 11% cases were having relevant yog in Original Birth grid.
- 15% cases where relevant yog were formed during the Dasha and
- 4% cases where no Yog formed during ongoing Mahadasha, Antardasha, Varshfal or Gochar.

Summary

The birth date is of great importance in any individual's life as Nathaniel West said,

“Numbers constitute the only universal language”.

The above study & analysis clearly shows that each & every number has its own potential to achieve the goals of life, as well as they also define the struggles of life onto the same path.
